Ladies dress: Grey/white regulation bowling skirt/trousers/shorts together with a Club shirt or white top and green waistcoat for all matches. Whites, which can include a Club shirt, must be worn for all matches and competitions unless otherwise stated.

Men's dress: Grey trousers/regulation shorts with a Club shirt or white shirt for midweek games. White trousers/regulation shorts with a Club shirt or white shirt with club badge for weekend matches. A tie is to be worn for all matches.

Regulation bowling shoes are obligatory at all times on the green.

At all times, members must give careful consideration to the delivery of their bowls. Bowls should be delivered in such a manner as not to cause damage to the green.

When selected for matches for the club, all bowls must display LBC stickers. These are available from the bowls secretary, or the captains.

Please enter your competition games and times and the name of the marker (in singles) in the desk diary provided. The captains will allocate the rink number.

The green shall not be open for play on any weekday before noon, nor shall it be open on any Saturday, Sunday, or bank holiday before 10.30am. Any situation arising that necessitates any alteration of the rule can be done only with the express permission of either captain.
(Rule 8 of the Bowls Section)

**The Bar will be open on certain Sundays.
Dates and times will be posted on the notice board.**

RULES OF THE BOWLING SECTION

1. Membership of the section shall be open to Ladies and Gentleman subject to the approval of the Management Committee of the Club.
2. The following shall be elected by ballot at each Annual General Meeting: **Men's Captain and Committee Chairman, Ladies Captain, Men's Vice-Captain, Ladies Vice-Captain, Hon. Men's and Committee Secretary, Hon Ladies Secretary, Hon Men's Match Secretary, Hon. Ladies Match Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, One Male and One Female Committee Member.**
3. The Management of the section shall be in the hands of a Committee, which shall consist of all those elected at the most recent Annual General Meeting. The elected members shall retire annually but shall be eligible for re-election. At all meetings of the Committee, five shall form a quorum. **Members standing for election to the Bowls Committee must have a minimum of two years' membership.**
4. In the event of a vacancy on the committee during any year, the Committee shall have the power to fill each vacancy.
5. The Committee shall have the power to co-opt members to serve on the committee for special purposes and to appoint sub-committees as the occasion may arise.
6. All games shall be played under the rules of Bowls England, with the exception that, at the agreement of both teams, a refreshment break may be taken.
7. The Bowling season shall commence on an agreed Saturday in April, and close on an agreed Sunday in September.
8. **(a)** the green shall not be open for play on any weekday before noon, or on any Saturday, Sunday or bank holiday before 10.30am.
(b) Any situation arising that necessitates any alteration to 8 (a) shall only be done with the express permission of either Captain.
9. Before or during play (in the absence of either Captain) members of the committee present shall appoint one of their number to act as Deputy Captain.
10. The Committee shall decide the conditions for all competitions and matches that may be played on rinks reserved for that purpose, but rinks cannot be reserved without the consent of the Captains or their Deputies.
11. The Committee shall appoint a Liaison Officer who, with both Captains, shall form a Green Committee, which shall be responsible for maintenance of the Green, Any of them present shall have the authority to prohibit play.

12. Roll-ups – when sufficient members are present:

(a) Disc shall be drawn to make up sides. Ordinary games shall consist of 12 ends. Extra ends can be played but a game must not extend beyond 6pm if that rink has been booked for a Match or Competition, or whilst any member is waiting for a game. This specially applies to games starting at 4.30pm.

(b) During play, players shall wear the recognised Bowls shoes. Men shall wear plain grey trousers together with a predominately white top attire. Ladies shall wear grey/white bowls skirts/trousers together with a white top. Additionally club regulation cardigans may be worn.

(c) For matches/special occasions, players shall wear white skirt/trousers with a white top, club tie (men) and club badge. Additionally, club cardigans (ladies) may be worn. White shoes are preferred unless otherwise stated.

13. Members shall be allowed to practise on a vacant rink and others may join them, but no pre-arranged game may be played without the express permission of the Captains or their Deputies.

14. The Annual General Meeting shall be held no later than the middle of December in each year. Nominations for officers for the ensuing year shall be sent to the Secretary or posted on the notice board not less than 14 days before the Meeting.

15. A Special General Meeting shall be convened by the Committee when necessary, within 28 days of receipt of a request to the Secretary in writing, signed by no fewer than 25 members, specifying the Meeting objective.

16. Any alteration of or addition to these rules, details of which must be given on the notice convening the Meeting, may be made by a majority of the members present at a General Meeting, subject to the approval of the Management Committee of the club. Notice of any Proposed alteration shall be in the hands of the Secretary 28 days before the Meeting.

17. For all General Meetings, seven days' notice of such shall be given. Twenty members to form a quorum.

18. The Committee shall have the power to decide any question of, or arising out of, these rules or the interpretation thereof – and their decision shall be final.

NOTE: Annual General Meeting means Annual General Meeting of the section.
